



Post Operative Instructions for the Sedation Patient

All patients must be accompanied during recovery. Patients may sleep, but must be watched for at least 6 hours after treatment.

Please escort the patient from the vehicle to the house by supporting them under the arm.

The patient must be conscious and aware before any additional pain medication can be given. Wait at least 2-4 hours or as directed by your doctor.

Do not give food until the patient is fully awake and can speak and breathe well.

Being cold is normal. Use blankets as needed.

The patient should be alert enough to respond to questions or ask questions.

Leave the post-op instruction sheet and medication out for patient to find easily.
